

Enrollment Freeze for Gold Hill Elementary School.

The Fort Mill School District Board of Trustees has extended the enrollment freeze for Gold Hill Elementary for the 2009-2010 school year.

This is the sixth time that the district has used an enrollment freeze to address rapid overcrowding of a school. Each elementary school is designed to hold approximately 900 students and the existing enrollment at Gold Hill is near capacity.

The new freeze will take effect on June 6 for new students who move into the attendance area on or after that date.



The district will provide shuttle bus transportation for affected students to Springfield Elementary. The district does reserve the right to adjust the freeze as needed.
